



VIBRANT VILLAGE POST SUMMER 2015

1. A reminder to all residents that there is no burning allowed in the Village.
2. Come and enjoy the Red Hook Village Farmers' Market located in the Municipal Parking Lot next to the Village Hall every Saturday, from May through October, from 10:00 am – 2 pm.

3. **Abrahams Park 4th Annual Community Concert and Potluck** – Saturday, August 22nd from 5:00 pm to 8:00 pm. Come join us for live music by GrassFed BlueGrass and bring a dish to share!
4. The Village Offices will be closed on Friday July 3, in observance of Independence Day and Monday, September 7, in observance of Labor Day.

*** Garbage & Recycling pick-up, as well as brush pick-up, will be on Tuesday, September 8th. ***

Please note there is a 50 lb. weight limit on the large garbage bags with the red tags. Please do not overfill the bags!

Reminder - the Village of Red Hook is now doing single stream recycling. All recyclables (paper, co-mingled, and newspaper) can now be placed together in a proper plastic container for pick-up. Recycling is free with the purchase of garbage tags. *Please do not over fill containers. Also, please drill holes in the bottom of the containers in order to drain any rain water.*

5. **Brush Pick-up** – A reminder that brush pick-up in the Village takes place every first and third Monday of the month through November. Please limit the amount of brush piles to one pile per house. The pile is not to be larger than 6' x 6' x 6', with tree limbs/branches no larger than 8" in diameter. Grass clippings must be kept separate from leaves or they will not be picked up. **(Please do not include tree trunks and debris from tree maintenance performed by private contractors. These will be the responsibility of the property owner. Residents not honoring these restrictions/recommendations may be charged a fee for removal by the Village of Red Hook.)**
6. Residents interested in donating scrap metal can contact Highway Superintendent Dan Streib at 845-758-8600 or Village Clerk Cynthia Cole at 845-758-1081 to arrange for pick-up. Proceeds from the sale of scrap metal will be used to purchase equipment for the Village of Red Hook Highway and Waste Recovery Departments.
7. Please be considerate of your friends and neighbors. If you have a dog please be sure to monitor and stop any bothersome barking. Village residents are entitled to quiet, peaceful enjoyment of their own yards so please be cognizant of your dog's behavior. **Also, please remember to remove all dog feces and deposit in a sanitary manner.**
