1. Reminder: The Village Clerk's and Planning and Zoning offices are now located behind the Village Building, which is a white building located at 6 Prince Street. The Red Hook Police Department is located in an office trailer in the Village Parking Lot. All board meetings will be held at the Red Hook Fire House. Village Court will hold their offices and court at the Town of Red Hook. Court will be held on the first and third Wednesday of each month, unless otherwise posted.
2. Please do not park in front of the new Village office location. These parking spots are reserved for tenants.
3. There will be no water bill slot available to drop off any payments.
4. Please remember to shovel all fire hydrants of snow and ice.
5. Village elections will be held on March 20th at the Red Hook Fire House.
6. Please do not mix commingle with newspaper
7. Residents are reminded of the 2 hour parking within the business district. The Red Hook Police will be strictly enforcing this law. Also, there is no parking along any Village streets until March 31st.
8. SIDEWALKS – RESIDENTS HAVE 48 HOURS TO REMOVE ANY SNOW OR ICE FROM SIDEWALKS.
9. A reminder to have all Christmas trees curbside by January 31, 2007 for removal.
10. The landfill is closed effective December 15th, 2006 and will reopen in the spring.
